Authorization for Consumption of DNA Evidence

Some types of evidence may be consumed during the course of DNA analysis. When possible, LSP Crime Lab DNA Analysts will make every effort to preserve the evidence and/or an extract. The LSP Crime Lab requires that the submitting agency acknowledge this and provide authorization to consume the evidence when needed. If written permission is not received within 30 days of submission of the evidence, the case may be closed and evidence returned unless sufficient justification is provided.

It is the responsibility of the submitting agency to determine their authority to authorize such consumption. Consultation with and/or authority from your District Attorney's Office may be required in some instances.
